

Dell Atlante Lessicale Degli Antichi Volgari Italiani

Paul Videsott examines the fate of the vernacular non-literary written language in Northern Italy from its first appearance up to 1525 (the year of publication of P. Bembo's Prose della volgar lingua). For this, he undertakes a scriptological and scriptometric analysis of 1165 non-literary Old North Italian texts with a total of 558,892 words from 35 writing centres. Overall, one result is that the North Italian dialects displayed a far greater autonomy towards the emerging Tuscan norm than was the case in France for the Northern French dialects vis-à-vis the imperial Parisian standard language.

The 15th-century ms. 534 of Biblioteca Universitaria di Padova (Italy) contains an extensive Latin-Bergomasco glossary, known through its 1893 edition prepared by the German scholar Jean Étienne Leuck. This publication offers a new edition of this text, based on 21st-century editing principles and standards, and helps gain valuable new insight into the broad linguistic and leical material the glossary preserves.

The annals of the XXVI Congress of the Société de Linguistique Romane bring together some 500 lectures on 16 subjects: phonetics and phonology, morphology and syntax, semantics, lexicology/phraseology, morphology, onomastics, sociolinguistics, language geography, pragmatics, communication analysis, textual linguistics of earlier language stages, electronic media, translation studies, creole languages, Vulgar Latin, and linguistic history. Also included are ten plenary lectures and five round table discussions. The papers, written solely in the Romance languages (French, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese, and Romanian), offer a current panorama of Romance linguistics, its present-day fields of research, as well as the latest bibliographic information.

A Linguistic History of Italian offers a clear and concise explanation of why modern Italian grammar has become the way it is. It focuses on the effects of historical changes on the modern structure of Italian, revealing patterns and structures which are not always apparent to those who are only familiar with modern Italian. Although the book concentrates on the internal history of the language, the emergence of Italian is considered against the wider background of the history of Italian dialects, and other external factors such as cultural and social influences are also examined.

Il glossario, frutto di una ricerca, tuttora in corso, che si è dipanata per molti anni fra documenti di archivio e osservazioni sul costruito, costituisce un ulteriore tassello che va a inserirsi in un più ampio lavoro sulla storia del costruire genovese, nel cui ambito sono già usciti nella Collana i volumi dedicati al rinnovo architettonico a Genova tra XVI e XVII secolo e alle relative modifiche nelle tecniche costruttive e nei materiali utilizzati. Il glossario è in ordine alfabetico, ma è stato inserito nel volume anche un indice tematico dei termini suddivisi a seconda dell'ambito del significato, in maniera da consentire anche una ricerca per categoria tematica.

Der Autor wollte in dieser Dissertation die Haltbarkeit bisher für keltisch oder vorromanisch gehaltener Lexeme im romanischen Wortschatz kritisch hinterfragen und gegebenenfalls alternative Vorschläge zur Etymologie machen. Während sich die Keltizität einzelner romanischer Lexeme klar bestätigt hat, konnten für viele der bisher im LEI publizierten Praeromanica auch alternative romanisch-lateinische Deutungen oder aus dem germanischen Superstrat vorgebracht werden. Der Einfluß des Keltischen oder Sorothaptischen auf den romanischen Wortschatz scheint also weniger bedeutend gewesen zu sein als bisher gedacht. Auch oskisch-umbrische oder etruskische Lexeme hatten so gut wie keinen Einfluß auf das romanische Lexikon.

This manual aims to provide a systematic and up-to-date overview of Italian linguistics taking into account new research topics such as Italian outside of Italy, historical varieties, or the syntactic properties of early Italian. Particular focus will be placed on linguistic subfields that have grown more important and relevant in the past years and decades, such as pragmatics, textual linguistics, corpus linguistics, or language acquisition.

In Dynamics of Morphological Productivity, Francesco Gardani explores the evolution of the productivity of the noun inflectional classes of Latin and Old Italian, providing a wealth of cleverly organized empirical facts, accompanied by brilliant and groundbreaking analyses.

The Diarii, faithful chronicle of the years between 1496 and 1533 written by the Venetian patrician Marino Sanuto, are considered an indispensable reference work for research on the late Renaissance. This present study provides a detailed linguistic and philological analysis of the Diarii, based on the edition Fulin et al. (1879-1903) as well as on excerpts of autographic manuscripts (Marc.it. VII, 228-286).

The achievements of Romance language corpus-driven studies deserve more attention from the scientific community at the world level for both their quantity and quality. This book contains papers given at the 3rd International LABLITA Workshop in Corpus Linguistics (Italian Department, University of Florence, June 4th-5th 2008), and it aims at integrating new ideas and results derived from Romance language corpora in the framework of the overall achievements of Corpus Linguistics. The volume contains the contribution of a leading scholar of Corpus Linguistics (Douglas Biber), and a set of articles presented to Biber by notable European researchers and those from other countries. Papers report on long-term studies ranging from Italian to Spanish, French, Brazilian Portuguese and Japanese.

This manual contains a description of the existing anthologies and corpora that have so far been compiled for the Romance languages. It takes into account the standard languages and a selection of well-attested diatopic and diastatic varieties as well as Romance-based Creoles. Representative texts are provided for all varieties discussed.

Vom 28. - 31. August 2011 fand in Lavin das fünfte Rätoromanistische Kolloquium statt. An diesem Kolloquium nahmen beinahe alle wichtigen Forscher teil, die sich mit bündnerromanischer, dolomitenladinischer und friaulischer Sprache und Literatur beschäftigen. Die dort gehaltenen Vorträge gaben einen hervorragenden Überblick über die laufenden Untersuchungen, Projekte und Ergebnisse auf dem Gebiet dieser drei Sprachgruppen und ihrer Probleme als Minderheitensprachen. Diese Vorträge sind nun in diesem Sammelband thematisch zusammengestellt und dokumentieren damit den Stand der aktuellen Arbeiten auf dem Gebiet der Rätoromanistik auch für ein breiteres Publikum.

This book evaluates the predictions of syllable-based analyses of Italian in three domains: native speaker intuition of consonant cluster syllabification, definite article allomorphy, and segment duration, and tests the claimed convergence of multiple phenomena on the same syllable structure.

The Deonomasticon Italicum provides a systematic historical treatment of, and commentary on, the lexemes of Italian derived from proper names. It covers both derivations from geographical names (including those from ethnic roots, which are of especial interest both for the history of vocabulary and for cultural history) and from the names of persons. The first part of the Dictionary (4 volumes) is devoted to derivations from geographical names, the second (2 volumes) to the names of persons. The Deonomasticon Italicum will be published in complete volumes and no longer in the form of single fascicles.
